

- 3,000 credit students enrolled

- 75% of students receive financial aid to help them graduate debt-free

 - Nursing (RN) application will open August 1, 2020 through October 30, 2020 for a potential Fall 2021 start














The BC3 Student Experience: College Now Program

- Must meet certain GPA requirement and be a high school sophomore, junior, or senior
- Fill out a College Now Agreement and provide an official high school transcript
- Can take classes at any BC3 location or online










The BC3 Student Experience: Becoming a BC3 Student: The Steps

- **Open Admissions Policy = no ACT or SAT scores required but** may exempt you from placement testing
- **Apply for FREE May 8th** through May 17th at www.bc3.edu/apply
- Send official high school transcript and GED/HiSET scores (if applicable)
- Send official college/university transcripts (if applicable)



Community College (BC3) must submit a completed application for admission whether or not they intend to obtain a certificate or degree.

All persons who plan to take credit courses and programs, whether or not they intend to obtain a certificate or degree, are required to submit a \$25 applica-tion processing be payable to BC3. The application fee is a one-time only, NON-REFUNDABLE fee to cover the cost of establishing a permanent

Returning BC3 Students Students who have applied to or have attended BC3 in the past for credit courses and are returning to the College after a delay of one academic year (fall, spring, summer), must complete a new application for admission.

The \$25 application processing fee is NOT required for re-admission.
