## ***The ABC's of Advising***

### ***What is Advisement By Choice (ABC)?***

Under **Advisement By Choice**, you have the opportunity to choose how you will be advised. You are always encouraged to talk with your assigned Faculty Advisor or with an Academic Counselor, but if you feel confident with your ability to select your own courses, you are permitted to register without an advisor's or counselor's signature.

### ***Why should you see your advisor?***

- ✓ Have you met the prerequisite requirements?
- ✓ Are you taking the correct courses for your program of study?
- ✓ Are your remaining courses offered fall only/ spring only?
- ✓ Have you met program requirements to graduate?
- ✓ Are you considering changing your major?
- ✓ Will dropping a course prevent you from graduating?
- ✓ Will dropping a course impact your financial aid or your parents' insurance?

### ***Who will NOT be permitted to use Advisement By Choice?***

New full-time (including transfer) students at BC3

Students on probation

Students readmitted after suspension or dismissal

Students enrolled in:

General studies-undecided; 100U

General studies-developmental; 100D

Nursing

Physical Therapist Assistant

Medical Assistant

Massage Therapy

Paramedic
