Nondestructive Testing/ Inspection Technologies

Professionals in nondestructive testing utilize specialized techniques to ensure that structures and components are safe without damaging the objects. Bridge cables, roller coaster supports, aircraft skins, nuclear equipment and numerous other materials are regularly tested by professionals in this field. This 12-week certificate will cover all of the most common testing methods to prepare individuals for entry into this growing field. With the increased need for employees in the energy and power generation cluster, this certificate prepares individuals to immediately enter a rewarding and well paying career.

This program provides instruction in 5 of the most common nondestructive testing methods. Methods training includes: Visual Testing (VT), Liquid Penetrant Testing (PT), Magnetic Particle Testing (MT), Radiographic Testing (RT), and Ultrasonic Testing (UT). The training program meets or exceeds the guidelines or requirements of the American Society for Nondestructive Testing (ASNT) documents SNT-TC-1A, CP-189 and NAS 410. Graduates of this program will find employment in the power generation industry (Nuclear, Fossil Fuel, Wind, etc), petro-chemical industry (fuel manufacturing and pumping facilities), steel (manufacturing and finishing), fabrication and machine shops, military (all branches), automotive, railroad, mining, and more.

Planning for Emergencies & Disasters

Weather emergencies, terrorism incidents, influenza outbreaks and man-made disasters are all unfortunate realities in contemporary society. Good planning for unusual events helps avoid the errors and omissions likely to occur when little or no forethought is given to emergency situations.
