BLS FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

This program comprises modules of adult one and two rescuer CPR, pediatric CPR, and barrier devices. All persons participating in a BLS Healthcare provider course will be trained in the use of a mask with a one-way valve. A written evaluation and manikin skill evaluation are part of the course. This course is for a student with no current certification or has had a lapse in certification that works or intends to work in the medical field.
