

# EMS and Police Training Schedule

## PHLEBOTOMY PROGRAMS

The purpose of this course is to instruct health care professionals on the correct method of performing capillary puncture and venipuncture. In addition, the student will be able to utilize and explain the purpose of the various equipment, including the safety equipment. The student will also be familiar in the use of the correct terminology regarding capillary puncture, venipuncture, safety, and vacutainer blood collection. Upon successful completion of the program, which includes 48 classroom hours and a minimum of 100 clinical hours, the student will be eligible to take the National Phlebotomy Certification Examination if desired. Tuition does not include National Examination fee.

Students must provide personal medical coverage. You will receive a registration packet 6-8 weeks prior to the start of the course containing forms necessary to complete the clinical prerequisites, including those explaining specific lab work, clearances, and immunizations. Any costs incurred for the completion of these clinical prerequisites will be the financial responsibility of the student. Due to the length of the program, **attendance at ALL sessions is mandatory**. Failure to meet the attendance requirements will directly result in immediate removal from the program without refund.

Textbooks are required for the first day of class and are NOT included in the tuition. Textbooks can be purchased at the college's bookstore by calling 724-287-8711, ext. 8230. Class size is limited to 12-14 students. Students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. **There is a 30 day cancellation policy for this course. Refunds will not be issued after that time.**
