BC3 to serve as Butler County COVID-19 testing location for Primary Health Network

(Butler, PA) A community health center will offer free COVID-19 tests at a drive-up, outdoor location on Butler County Community College's main campus in Butler Township.

Primary Health Network, Sharon, will administer the nasal-swab tests on designated dates through December in BC3's Parking Lot 5.

BC3 is serving as Primary Health Network's testing location in Butler County.

Those seeking a COVID-19 test from Primary Health Network are required to be evaluated through a telehealth appointment with one of the community health center's providers. Those who meet criteria for a COVID-19 test will be scheduled for an appointment.

The only cost to the patient is for the initial telehealth evaluation, according to Primary Health Network. The community health center accepts all patients, regardless of insurance status or ability to pay. It participates in most managed-care plans, processes most insurances and offers a sliding fee scale to eligible patients for discounted services.
