

Open House for BC3's Manufacturing Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate at Penn United

(Butler, PA) An Open House will be held for Butler County Community College's Manufacturing Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate on Wednesday, September 14 from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Carl E. Jones Learning Center at Penn United Technologies, Inc. The Manufacturing Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate allow students to develop the entry-level skills needed to start a career in manufacturing.

Classes will be held Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. starting Monday, October 24 through Thursday, December 15 at Penn United Technologies, Inc. Topics include basic shop safety and equipment operation, blueprint reading, quality and manufacturing processes and procedures, and an introduction to CNC. Students earning the certificate will have the opportunity to earn two NIMS and three NTMA credentials. The certificate can also be applied towards earning a Workplace Certificate in Basic Manufacturing from BC3.

At the Open House, potential students can tour the classrooms at Penn United and talk with staff. Representatives from local manufacturing companies will be available to discuss employment opportunities after completion of the certificate. Funding options are available for eligible students.
