Pioneers' Rozzi falls 2 strokes shy of All-American status

Michael Rozzi, a 2016 graduate of Neshannock High School and a sophomore on the Butler County Community College golf team, finished in a tie for 21st place at the National Junior College Athletic Association Division III national championships and fell two strokes shy of All-American status.

Rozzi ended the four-round tournament Friday with a 318, tied with Anthony Miller, of Jamestown Community College, Jamestown, N.Y.

Those placing in the Top 18 at Chautauqua Golf Club earned All-American status. Brett Dearhouse, of Onondaga Community College, Syracuse, N.Y., finished No. 18 with a 316.

Dan Lapp, of Tompkins Community College, Dryden, N.Y., won the tournament with a 293.

The Pioneers' Noah Morgan, a 2016 graduate of Allegheny-Clarion Valley High in Foxburg and BC3 freshman, placed No. 59 with a 346.

Rozzi scored a tournament second-best 44 pars in 72 holes.
